



The book, initiated by and dedicated to Prof. Wolfgang Draf (1940-2011) contains a wealth of information for the whole endonasal endoscopic skull base team. Prominent interdisciplinary specialists have contributed to chapters from basic anatomy to the technique of extracranial-intracranial bypass surgery.

The book starts with basics like anatomy of the skull base and the etiology, biology and pathology of skull base tumours and of course imaging and endovascular treatment. The chapters of the book discuss the multidisciplinary approach necessary for proper treatment of these tumours, various technical chapters on routes to the tumour and tumour specific strategies. The chapter on tumour specific strategies has only chapters on inverted papilloma, JNA's, esthesioneuroblastoma, meningioma and chordoma. Finally there are some useful chapters on reconstruction and complications. Complete with 500 full-color photographs, anatomic illustrations, flowcharts and tables, Endonasal Endoscopic Surgery of Skull Base Tumors offers a practical management approach and a must have for endonasal endoscopic skull base teams.
